“Intercultural Parents' Cafe is a parent education program that is primarily aimed at parents and at the educational institutions / organizations in which the program takes place.

Parents are specifically invited to their children's educational institutions or to migrant organizations, where after a spontaneous speech, over coffee and cake, a thematic exchange takes place with the speakers. In this way, an attempt is made to strengthen parents in their upbringing and educational skills, or to promote communication and cooperation between

kindergartens / schools, parents and children, so that certain challenges are solved more easily, and children are better accompanied in the Austrian education system can.

Goals

- Strengthening the parenting and educational skills of the participating parents
- Improve cooperation between educational institutions and parents
- Strengthening the self-confidence and self-esteem of the participating parents
- Supporting parents in accessing their children's educational institutions
- Strengthening parent work
- Expanding educational opportunities for children of participating parents
- Strengthening the social and intercultural skills of everyone involved
- Strengthening togetherness and social cohesion

Program offer

Intercultural parent café takes place up to eight times in the school year with 2 teaching units (50 minutes each) at regular intervals. The implementation of the program at various locations in Upper Austria is supported by the parent café coordinators of the Intercultural Pedagogy Institute of the VHS Upper Austria. If necessary, childcare can also be offered. Topics related to parenting, education, health, social media, human rights, multilingualism, interculturality, etc. are dealt with.
