



Intercultural lecture

"Intercultural lecture" is an adult education program that is primarily aimed at educators, trainers, social workers, parents, community workers and at the educational institutions / organizations in which the program takes place.

The participants are specifically invited to certain institutions or to the migrant self-organizations, where a thematic exchange with the experts takes place after a specialist lecture. The lectures deal with various developments in the areas of society, education and upbringing in an intercultural context.

Goals

- Deepening of the intercultural knowledge and understanding of the participants
- Strengthening the participants in their parenting and / or educational skills
- Strengthening the participants' intercultural skills
- Promotion of intercultural communication and everyday cooperation
- Strengthening togetherness and social cohesion

Program offer

Several intercultural lectures, each lasting 2 hours, are held throughout Upper Austria during the year. After the lecture, a discussion with the speaker will be offered. Topics related to interculturality, education, upbringing, health, living together, human rights, multilingualism, social media, etc. are dealt with. If necessary, childcare can also be organized.
