



Learning support and homework support

“Learning & homework support” is a student support program aimed at compulsory school children (VS, MS and lower secondary school) as well as at the educational institutions / organizations in which the program takes place.

The students receive support in the subjects of mathematics, German and English with their homework as well as with learning and preparation for exams. They learn “how to learn”, taking into account their individual learning support plans, whereby the dedicated learning guides also orientate themselves towards the life world and history of the students.

Goals

- Expanding chances of a positive completion of compulsory school
- Strengthening the independence and learning skills of the participating students
- Improve school integration
- Strengthening the self-esteem of the participating students
- Strengthening the social and intercultural skills of everyone involved
- Strengthening togetherness and social cohesion

Program offer

The learning and homework support supervision takes place from October to June, one to three times a week (depending on need) for 2 units (50 minutes each), mainly in educational institutions and migrant organizations throughout Upper Austria.

The aim is to work as individually as possible according to the needs of the pupils. The basis for this is social, communicative and intercultural learning with and from each other.
