„Sprachförderwoche“ is a language and learning support program for compulsory school children, which primarily aims to intensively promote the German language.

After the long summer vacation, the children are prepared for the new school year by dedicated educators and supervisors. In a stimulating learning environment, the first or second language German is refreshed and existing language skills are deepened.

A special concern is also to involve the mothers in the language support, which is why a German course is offered for them, with a focus on school and everyday topics.

Goals

- Refreshing and improving German skills
- Prepare for school
- Improve collaboration between school, parents and children
- Promotion of the learning motivation of the participating children
- Strengthening the self-esteem of the participating children and their mothers
- Strengthening the social and intercultural skills of everyone involved
- Strengthening togetherness and social cohesion

Program offer

The language support week of the IIP usually takes place in the first school week from 1:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m. in a school. The children are divided into three age groups and a fourth group offers the German course for the mothers, which also has its own childcare.

In the course of the lessons, particular emphasis is placed on speaking, telling, reading and writing texts. After class, the garden or gymnasium is used for common language and introductory games.
