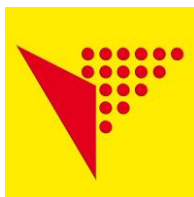

Finding the common language in multilingualism



The Institute for Intercultural pedagogy (IIP) is part of the non-profit educational institution Volkshochschule Oberösterreich and is active in the social pedagogical and intercultural field. With approx. 350 courses and lectures, the IIP reaches around 4,000 participants per year and, thanks to its many years of experience, can build on its intercultural competence and create access to target groups that are difficult to reach.

Goals

The central aim of the IIP is to support the Upper Austrian municipalities, educational institutions and various migrant self-organizations in the field of intercultural pedagogy, to strengthen parents in their parenting and educational skills and to support children in the Austrian education system.

The Institute for Intercultural Pedagogy strives to improve the educational opportunities of all participants, to promote cooperation and to strengthen social cohesion.

Target Groups

The target groups of the institute primarily include parents and their children who have special support needs due to their social background and / or migration experience.

Offers

The institute's offers take place across Upper Austria and are aimed at all age groups. The IIP comprises four core areas in which various programs are implemented:

- Support on early stages
- Support by studying
- Language support
- Parent work

The measures are offered and carried out on behalf of the state of Upper Austria and many Upper Austrian municipalities. Over 200 trainers and supervisors work at the IIP. Most of them are multilingual and bring personal experiences from everyday intercultural experience.
