



Mother learns German

The language support program "Mama learns German" aims to promote the German language and at the same time to promote the social participation of women (mainly mothers) whose first language is not German. The focus of these courses is not only on learning German as such, but also integrative educational modules (excursions, lectures), as well as the contact between parents and kindergarten / school.

The course is led by dedicated German trainers and is based on the life and history of the participants in order to strengthen them for everyday life. In addition to a building grammar, topics of everyday life are dealt with (education system, family, health, housing, labor market, human rights, festivals and customs, etc.).

Goals

- Acquisition / improvement of German language skills
- Promotion of social participation of women with an immigration history
- Strengthening the participants' self-esteem
- Improve communication between participants and their children's educational institutions
- Increased motivation for further training among the participants
- Increasing the social and intercultural skills of everyone involved
- Strengthening togetherness and social cohesion

Program offer

"Mama learns German" course takes place from October to June, once a week for 2 lessons (50 minutes each), mainly in the educational institutions in which the participants' children are accommodated and in migrant organizations throughout Upper Austria.

Since the lessons take place in a familiar environment, the women can take part in the German course without additional effort. If necessary, childcare can also be offered.
