



Summer language camp

"Summer Language Camp" is a language and learning support program for compulsory school children, which primarily aims to intensively promote the German language. After the long summer vacation, the children are prepared for the new school year by dedicated educators and supervisors.

In a stimulating learning environment, the first or second language German is refreshed and existing language skills are deepened. The children find ideal ideas for this primarily in play and social interaction. The lessons are part of this learning environment and their content is closely linked to the activities of the camp.

Goals

- Refreshing and improving German skills
- Preparation for school
- Promotion of the learning motivation of the participating children
- Strengthening the self-esteem of the participating children
- Strengthening the social and intercultural skills of everyone involved
- Strengthening togetherness and social cohesion

Program offer

The summer language camp usually takes place in the third last and penultimate week of the holiday from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. at several locations (mainly schools) in Upper Austria. Classes are held in the morning and the afternoon is spent on useful leisure activities. Excursions are also made during the camp and a final party with lots of fun and games is organized on the last day.

The children's self-confidence in their own language skills should be strengthened and language and interaction games should enable children to experience themselves in a protected environment. For this reason, the summer language camp focuses on “learning in the game”.
